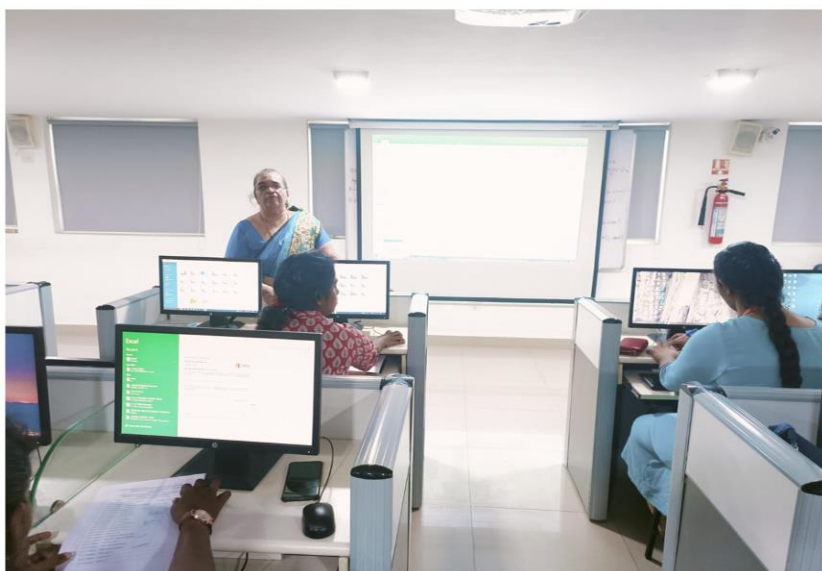

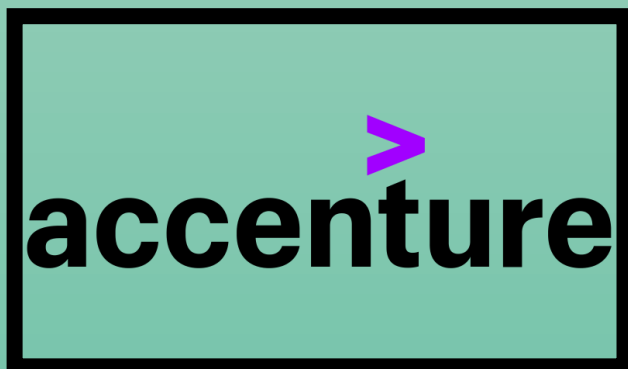

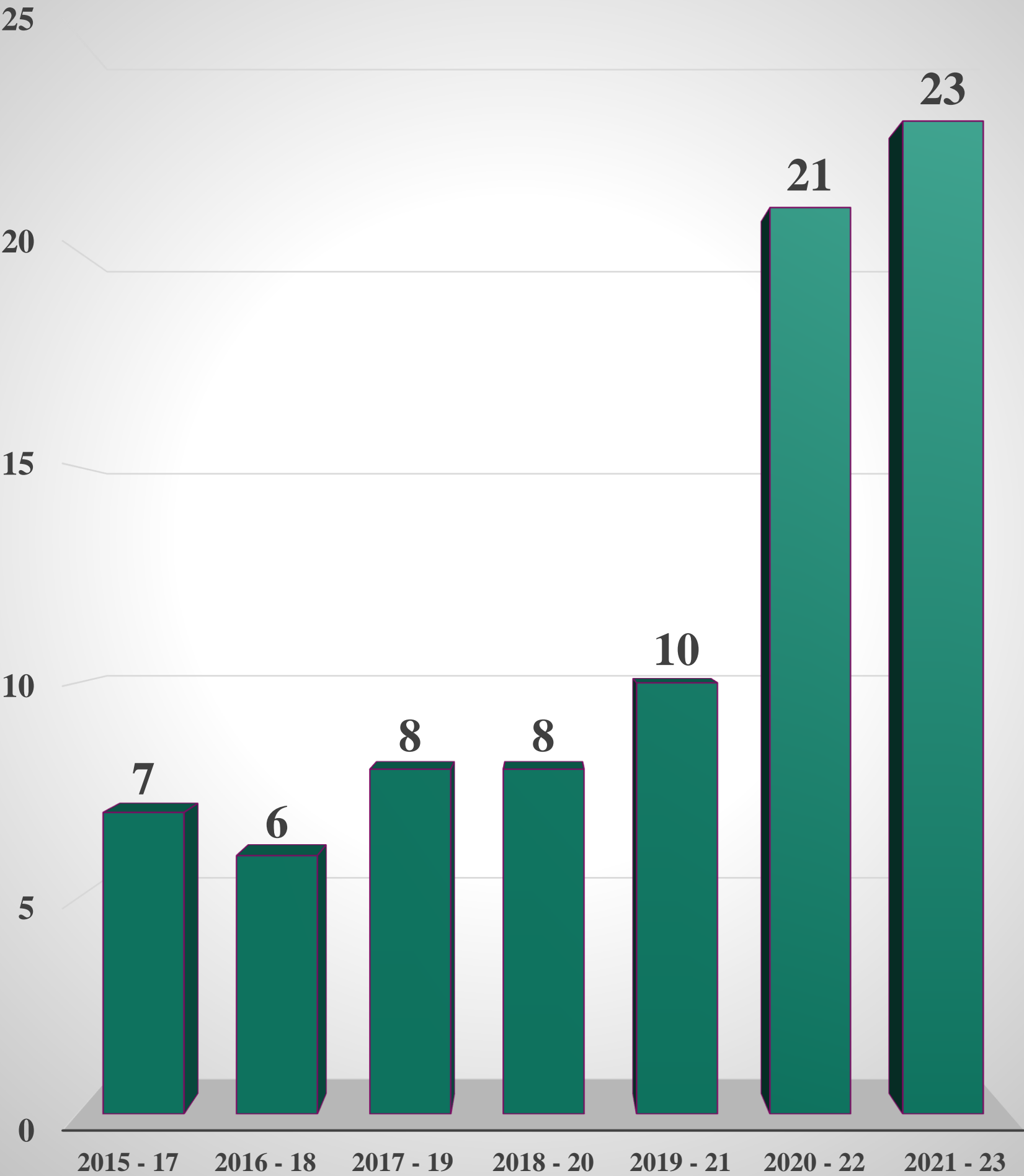


# PLACEMENTS
