PROMINENT ACTIVITIES


YOUNG ECONOMISTS SUMMIT (YES) - YES is an annual event organised by the ARTH Economics Club to train students in economic and social policy making. YES is a truly unique initiative where budding economists from colleges across the country come together to confer on an issue of national economic importance.

ARTH – The Economics Club focuses on providing students with a forum to interact, compete, debate, question and further develop their understanding of economics through myriad events. The association activities not only enable the students to explore and deepen their knowledge of economics, but also to learn and hone professional skills like collaboration, public speaking, leadership and organization. **ECONOMIC QUOTIENT (EQ)** is an outreach quiz program conducted by the Undergraduate Programme of Economics targeted at school students of Class II and 12. The purpose of EQ was to create awareness about Economics as a Subject in a fun and interesting way. In 2024-25 over 2000 students from 40 schools in Chennai participated in the final round of EQ!

ECON DIGEST (Journal) is the medium for the students to express their views on varied economic issues. Each year, the journal delves into a different theme. The students voice their thoughts and opinions in thought provoking and well-researched articles. The journal helps the students to build independent thinking skills as well as hone their writing and research capabilities.






