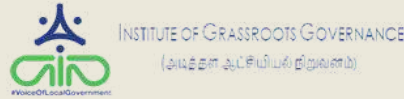

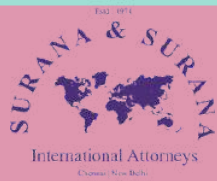

THINK TANK

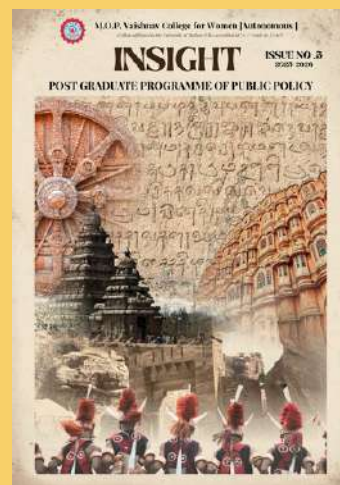


The Post Graduate Programme of Public Policy collaborated with Surana & Surana International Attorneys and established "Mind", an innovative think tank launched on 21st November 2024.
